

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval and acceptance of the United National Indian Tribal Youth/Robert Wood Johnson
Foundation Celebrate Native Health Grant, Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council FY 2007)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-018

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **Youth Council as the official voice for youth of the Tohono O'odham Nation per**
3 **Resolution NO. 95-216; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council was awarded the Celebrate Native Health**
5 **Grant from the United National Indian Tribal Youth (UNITY) and the Robert Wood**
6 **Johnson Foundation (RWJF), with a start up disbursement of \$2,000.00, then**
7 **\$10,000.00 to be disbursed in December of each year for three years; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council will seek yearly expenditure approval for**
9 **budget year 2008 and 2009 in the amount of \$10,000.00 each year; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget & Finance Committees have**
11 **reviewed the UNITY/RWJF budget which is hereby incorporated by this reference and**
12 **recommends approval for the first year of a three year grant.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
14 **and approves the UNITY/RWJF Grant in the total amount of \$32,000.00 over 3 years.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the**
16 **Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council UNITY/RWJF budget for \$12,000.00 for the**
17 **first year.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council will seek yearly**
19 **expenditure approval for FY 08 and FY 09 in the amount of \$10,000.00 each year.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairwoman and any Designated Official are authorized**
22 **to negotiate and execute this budget, provided however, any amendment affecting**
23 **the funds or funding levels of this budget shall be submitted for further prior**
24 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH. Day**
26 **of JANUARY, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**
