RESOLUTION NO. <u>07-025</u>

1	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to enact criminal and civil laws
2		governing the conduct of any person within the Tohono O'odham Nation" and to
3		provide laws "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,
4		education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"
5		(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(c)(6) and 1(c)(2)); and 1(c)(2)(2)(2)(2)(2)(2)(2)(2)(2)(2)(2)(2)(2)
6	WHEREAS,	while the Nation has existing laws governing the conduct of members and non-
7		members, these laws to do not adequately address animal control issues; and
8	WHEREAS,	in response to concerns over animal control, in part, raised by incidents in which
9		Nation's members have been maimed or killed by animals at large, the Domestic
10		AffairsCommitteedraftedTohonoO'odhamCodeTitle17, Chapter7-AnimalControl;
11		and
12	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee subsequently met with the Natural Resources
13		Department staff and amended the draft law in accordance with the
14		recommendations of the director and veterinarian's technician; and
15	WHEREAS,	the draft law was also distributed to the Tohono O'odham Police Department, Office
16		of the Attorney General, Prosecutor's Office, Advocate Program, Judicial Court for
17		review and comment; and
18	WHEREAS,	on July 19, 2006, Title 17, Chapter 7 - Animal Control was provided to all Districts for
19		a 30-day public comment period; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee reviewed the comments received and incorporated
21		suggestions into the revised draft Title 17, Chapter 7 - Animal Control, which is
22		incorporated by this reference and has been provided to the Legislative Council for
23		review; and
24	WHEREAS,	if enacted, this law would create a legal framework for
25		entering animal control services agreements;
26		 limiting the areas where animals may be at large;
27		• requiring identification tags;
28		• limiting the use of tie-outs;
29		 addressing vaccinations, diseased animals, and quarantines;

1	• dead animal disposal;
2	 control of vicious and destructive animals and owner liability;
3	 handling biting animals and animals harassing livestock;

5	 exercising jurisdiction over non-members and non-Indians for conduct in
6	violation of the Nation's laws; and
7	WHEREAS, if enacted, Title 17, Chapter 7 - Animal Control will improve the health, safety, and
8	welfare of the Nation's members.
9	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby adopts and enacts
10	Tohono O'odham Code Title 17, Chapter 7 - Animal Control.
