

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Amendment to Resolution Number 06-704 to Approve the No-Cost
Extension to Extend the Grant Program of the US Department of Homeland
Security, Office for Domestic Preparedness, 2004 State Homeland Security
Grant # 2004-GE-T4-0051 and the Unexpended Amount of \$756,009.40)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-082

- 1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants within the**
2 **program period that was introduced on 12/01/03 to individual states, to fund**
3 **equipment purchases and training by departments that provide public safety**
4 **services within their respective jurisdictions; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, on March 24, 2005, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant from the Arizona**
6 **Department of Emergency and Military Affairs in the amount of \$277,000 as part of**
7 **the 2004 State Homeland Security Grant Program which was approved from the**
8 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council through Resolution 05-489 and subsequently**
9 **signed by the Chairwoman; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, on December 05, 2005, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant from the**
11 **Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs in the amount of \$558,000.00**
12 **as a supplement to the 2004 grant program which was accepted by the Tohono**
13 **O'odham Legislative Council through Resolution 06-070; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of 2004 State Homeland Security Grant Program specify that**
15 **the active grant period is until November 30, 2006; and**
- 16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Office of Emergency Management requested and**
17 **received approval to re-authorize unexpended funds from the Tohono O'odham**
18 **Nation FY 2006 Budget into the FY 2007 Budget from October 1, 2006 through**
19 **November 30, 2006 through Resolution Number 06-704; and**
- 20 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Office of Emergency Management received a letter dated**
21 **November 16, 2006 from the Arizona Department of Homeland Security advising of**
22 **the US Department of Homeland Security's extension of the 2004 State Homeland**
23 **Security Grant Program to May 31, 2007 to expend funds and complete grant projects;**
24 **and**
- 25 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has requested for and received reimbursement funds**
26 **from the State of Arizona for equipment spent from the grant award total of**
27 **\$835,000.00, leaving a remaining balance of \$756,009.40; and**

1 WHEREAS, Grants and Contracts, the Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee, and Budget
2 & Finance Committee have reviewed and approved the budgets and supporting
3 documents.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
5 no-cost extension of the 2004 State Homeland Security Grant Program grant funds as
6 stated in the extension letter from the State of Arizona for the period of November 30,
7 2006 to May 31, 2007 in order to expend funds in the unexpended amount of
8 \$756,009.40 to complete necessary grant projects.

9 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation Office of Emergency Management is
10 authorized to expend funds from this grant in accordance with the terms of the grant
11 award period of December 01, 2003 to May 31, 2007.

12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day
13 of FEBRUARY, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-
14 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
15 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
16 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
17 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
18 Stat. 984).




