

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Selecting Representative Felicia Nunez for the Canoa Ranch Community Trust/
Oversight Committee and Wavalene Romero as the Nation's Alternate)**

RESOLUTION NO. 07-104

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult with**
2 **“State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their departments,**
3 **agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all**
4 **matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council.” (Constitution, Article**
5 **VI, Section 1(f)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Pima County Board of Supervisors formed the Canoa Ranch Community**
7 **Trust/Oversight Committee to advise the County and the Board of Supervisors**
8 **concerning the development and preservation of Canoa Ranch, including the**
9 **preservation of archeological sites; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Canoa Ranch Community Trust/Oversight Committee comprises fifteen**
11 **members and one alternate for each member; and**

12 **WHEREAS, Pima County has invited the Tohono O'odham Nation to select members for**
13 **appointment to the Canoa Ranch Community Trust/Oversight Committee; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Cultural Preservation Committee has been**
15 **delegated oversight of matters involving cultural preservation, including**
16 **archaeological preservation; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee has selected Representative Felicia Nunez to**
18 **serve on the Canoa Ranch Community Trust/Oversight Committee and selects**
19 **Wavalene Romero as the alternate.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
21 **select Representative Felicia Nunez as the Tohono O'odham Nation's representative**
22 **and selects Wavalene Romero as the Nation's alternate to serve on the Canoa Ranch**
23 **Community Trust/Oversight Committee; provided that (1) this resolution shall**
24 **supercede any prior selection of representatives to the Canoa Ranch Community**
25 **Trust/Oversight Committee and (2) either selection reflected in this Resolution shall**
26 **expire if the appointee vacates her elected office for any reason.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH. Day**
28 **of FEBRUARY, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,748.6 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; 692.2 NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
33 **Stat. 984).**
