

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing the United States Department of Homeland Security Customs and Border Protection to Expand the Law Enforcement Center Located in the Papago Farms Area)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 07-120**

1 **WHEREAS, on August 11, 2005, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") entered into a Lease**  
2 **and a Memorandum of Understanding authorizing use of about one acre of land at**  
3 **Papago Farms by the United States Department of Homeland Security Customs and**  
4 **Border Protection ("CBP"), and the Tohono O'Odham Nation Police Department**  
5 **("TOPD"), for a Law Enforcement Center (LEC), approved by Legislative Council**  
6 **Resolution No. 05-448; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the location of the LEC comprises an area that has been previously surveyed, and an**  
8 **Environmental Assessment addressing the impact to the environment is available;**  
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, the LEC has been in full operation since May 1, 2006, and agents from CBP and TOPD**  
11 **have utilized the facility for their operations; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the use of the LEC has increased the presence of CBP and TOPD agents, and has been**  
13 **a benefit to the surrounding communities and Nation; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the need for additional space at the LEC will become essential to facilitate support**  
15 **vehicles, to drill a water well (referenced in a separate resolution), and to provide an**  
16 **increased sense of security to surrounding communities.**

17 **WHEREAS, this proposal was presented at the Chukut Kuk District meeting held on November 18,**  
18 **2006, and was met with approval and support in the form of Chukut Kuk District**  
19 **Resolution No. 2006-63.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 21 **1. Authorizes CBP to expand the Law Enforcement Center at Papago Farms by 1.04**  
22 **acres of land, bringing the total area to approximately two 1.96 acres;**
- 23 **2. This increase will not affect the above referenced Memorandum of Understanding;**
- 24 **3. The additional land will be annotated in an updated Lease Agreement.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
26 **of MARCH, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,163.2 FOR; 84.5**  
27 **AGAINST; 193.1 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Section 1(i)(2) of Article VI and Section 2 of Article XVII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**  
29 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
30 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16**  
31 **of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
