

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendment No.1 to reduce the Water Resources Study Program FY2007 US
Environmental Protection Agency's Source Water Assessment Program budget
11-5020 by \$40,000.00)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-146

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the Water Resources Study
2 Program FY2007 US Environmental Protection Agency's Source Water Assessment
3 Program (SWAP) budget 11-5020 through Resolution 06-168, in the amount of
4 \$80,000.00; and

5 WHEREAS, the US Environmental Protection Agency has reduced the Nation's FY2007 SWAP grant
6 by \$40,000.00; and

7 WHEREAS, the amended FY 2007 SWAP grant is subject to the negotiated Indirect Cost rate
8 increase from 17.98 to 19.35%; and

9 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program FY2007 SWAP budget 11-5020 as amended has
10 been reviewed by the Legislative Water Resources Committee and the Legislative
11 Budget and Finance Committee.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
13 authorizes the reduction of the Water Resources Study Program FY2007 SWAP budget
14 11-5020, by the amount of \$40,000.00, in accordance with the budget attached hereto.

15 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
16 Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget, as
17 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the
18 budget shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
19 Legislative Council.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH.Day
21 of MARCH, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,021.45 FOR; -0-
22 AGAINST; 419.35 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
23 Section 1 (d)(2)& (3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted
24 by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
25 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
26 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
