

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the US Department of Homeland Security, Office of Grants and Training,
2006 State Homeland Security Grant#2006-GE-T6-0007 for \$44,500.00)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-151

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants within the**
2 **program period that was introduced on 07/01/06 to individual states, to fund**
3 **equipment purchases, training and other programs by departments that provide**
4 **public safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive funds through the respective state for**
6 **the purpose of obligating and distributing funds from the U.S. Department of**
7 **Homeland Security, Office of Grants and Training, Homeland Security Grant Program**
8 **on a reimbursement basis to finance equipment purchases, training costs and other**
9 **needs for homeland security; and**

10 **WHEREAS, on 01/16/07, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant from the Arizona**
11 **Department of Emergency and Military Affairs in the amount of \$44,500.00 as part of**
12 **the 2006 grant program for the purchase of specific equipment needed for enhancing**
13 **the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department Criminal Investigations and Anti-**
14 **Violence Unit; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the 2006 grant award of \$44,500.00 has been reviewed by the Office of Grants &**
16 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**
17 **Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative**
18 **Council.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and**
20 **approves the grant award of \$44,500.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono**
21 **O'odham Nation General Fund for the purchase of equipment needed for enhancing**
22 **the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department Criminal Investigations and Anti-**
23 **Violence Unit and further approves the indirect cost to administer this grant as it**
24 **stipulates within the grant program guidance.**

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation Office of Emergency Management is**
26 **authorized to expend funds on behalf of the Police Department from this grant in**
27 **accordance with the terms of the grant award period of 11/01/06 to 03/31/08, with any**
28 **extensions of time reasonably necessary which are approved by the granting agency**
29 **to be brought back to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for approval.**

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1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that by this resolution, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
2 **authorizes the Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson of the Nation to enter into any**
3 **necessary agreements and compliance certifications therefore accepting the above-**
4 **mentioned US Department of Homeland Security, State Homeland Security Grants**
5 **through self or signature authority.**

6 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH. Day**
7 **of MARCH, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,344.25 FOR; -0-**
8 **AGAINST; 96.55 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
9 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
10 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
11 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
12 **Stat. 984).**
