

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services Division  
of Senior Services Administration on Aging Title VI Grant Needs Assessment)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 07-223**

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Senior Services Division receives**  
2 **Administration on Aging Title VI Grant funding; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, Administration on Aging Title VI Grant funding has provided ongoing and beneficial**  
4 **services to the O'odham elderly; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, in 2004, the Legislative Council did approve the Cycle II Needs Assessment with**  
6 **Resolution 04-590 for the Title VI three year grant that commenced on April 1, 2005**  
7 **and will end on March 31, 2008; and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services, Senior Services**  
9 **Division will again submit an application to cover another three year grant**  
10 **commencing on April 1, 2008 to March 31, 2011 which is fiscal year 2009 to 2011; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, a requirement of the FY08 Administration on Aging grant application is a Needs**  
12 **Assessment in order to develop program objectives; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration on Aging awarded a**  
14 **grant to the University of North Dakota National Resource Center on Native Aging, to**  
15 **provide technical assistance on the health and social needs of Native elderly and to**  
16 **assist Tribes in conducting a needs assessment; and**
- 17 **WHEREAS, the Needs Assessment is designed to provide information on the following Native elder**  
18 **health care needs:**
- 19 • **General Health Status**
  - 20 • **Activities of Daily Living**
  - 21 • **Visual, Hearing and Dental**
  - 22 • **Tobacco and Alcohol Use**
  - 23 • **Nutrition, Exercise and Excess Weight**
  - 24 • **Social Support, Housing and Work**
- 25 **WHEREAS, the confidentiality of enrolled O'odham members and Tohono O'odham information**  
26 **is of the utmost importance; therefore the needs assessment information will be**  
27 **collected anonymously by tribal members and the information will be stored in a**  
28 **locked file cabinet and destroyed after a three year period.**

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1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby:**

- 2           **1. Approves the Tohono O'odham Nations participation in the Needs Assessment as**  
3           **required by the Administration on Aging, Title VI grant application.**
- 4           **2. Approves the University of North Dakota National Resource Center on Native**  
5           **American Aging to provide technical assistance for the needs assessment.**
- 6           **3. Approves that all information collected will not be released in any form without**  
7           **the expressed permission of the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

8           **The Tohono O'odham Nation's officials to wit: the Chairwoman and any designated**  
9           **official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the assessment provided**  
10          **however, that any amendment affecting the understanding shall be submitted for**  
11          **further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
13 **of APRIL, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,075.2 FOR; ~~0~~ AGAINST;**  
14 **~~0~~ NOT VOTING; and 365.6[10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**  
15 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
16 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
17 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
18 **Stat. 984).**


