

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving for Wildland Fire Management/ B.I.A-National Interagency Fire Center
Division Amendment No.1)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-228

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation/Department of Public Safety/Fire Department has taken**
2 **over Operations of the P.L. 93-638, Wildland Fire Management (Preparedness) from**
3 **the Bureau of Indian Affairs to operate the program indefinitely; and**

4 **WHEREAS, funding has been provided by BIA Wildland P.L. 93-638, for the operation of the**
5 **Wildland Fire Management (Preparedness); and will be utilized to provide emergency**
6 **services in saving of lives, property, and protect the natural resources and wildlife of**
7 **the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Wildland Fire Management Division/Fire Department request approval to include**
9 **the FY 2006 carry forward funds of \$188,356.65 to the original FY 2007 Budget; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Wildland Fire Management Division/Fire Department request approval to include**
11 **the additional \$27,474.00 for a claim settlement on a program vehicle, awarded by**
12 **Hudson Insurance Company to the original FY 2007 Budget.**

13 **NOW ,THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
14 **FY 2006 carry forward identified savings of \$188,356.65, the increase of \$27,474.00**
15 **awarded by the Hudson Insurance Company, and the FY 2007 IDC in the amount of**
16 **\$31,658.09 for a grand total of \$247,488.74. Also adding new line item 750 Major**
17 **Capitol to purchase new vehicle.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
19 **Nation's official, to wit; the Chairperson is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute**
20 **the contracts and plans, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding**
21 **or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this**
22 **Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH Day**
24 **of APRIL, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,694.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
25 **146.9 NOT VOTING; and 599.5 [11] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
26 **Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**
27 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
28 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
29 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
