

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 07 budget amendment No. 1 for DPS-Solid Waste Regulatory to purchase equipment, add to deficient lines, and to establish a new line item, 750-Major Capitol Equipment to allow purchase of two vehicles)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-229

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation DPS-Solid Waste Regulatory Office (SWRO) has savings
2 in the personnel and related fringe benefits line item; and

3 WHEREAS, the SWRO is in dire need of vehicles and replacement of a 1999 color printer; and

4 WHEREAS, SWRO requests to amend the FY 07 budget to use the savings to purchase two vehicles,
5 a color printer and the related expenses by the transfer of funds to 721-Supplies Other
6 and 771-RM Vehicles; and

7 WHEREAS, SWRO requests establishment of line item 750-Major Capitol Equipment to allow
8 transfer of funds to line item 750, to purchase the vehicles; and

9 WHEREAS, the changes will not change the bottom line budget amount for FY 07, nor affect the
10 scope of work.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it
12 hereby accepts, approves and authorizes Budget Amendment No. 1 for FY 07 Solid
13 Waste Regulatory Office and approves the addition of the new line item 750 Major
14 Capitol Equipment for the purchase of two vehicles.

15 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairperson is hereby authorized to
16 execute the attached budget and that any amendments affecting the funding or
17 funding levels of this budget shall be submitted for prior approval to the Tohono
18 O'odham Legislative Council.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH Day
20 of APRIL, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 968.1 FOR; 642.6 AGAINST;
21 230.6 NOT VOTING; and 599.5 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
22 Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
23 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
24 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
25 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


