

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2007 One Stop Division Bureau of Indian Affairs-477 Budget
Amendment/Modification #1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 07-247

1 **WHEREAS, the One Stop Division has been developed with the Native Employment Works**
2 **Program and the Arizona Department of Economic Security funding to promote**
3 **smooth transitional services for clients with an effective staff cost share to promote**
4 **de-centralized services; and**

5 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 07-035, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY**
6 **2007 One Stop Division Bureau of Indian Affairs-477 Budget in the amount of**
7 **\$899,698.34; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Grants & Contracts office has identified a close out amount from prior funding in**
9 **the amount of \$93,930.00 which will be added to the approved Education One Stop**
10 **Division base budget for a grand total of \$993,628.34; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education One Stop Division Budget has submitted for**
12 **review and approval the proposed FY 2007 Budget Modification-Amendment No.01,**
13 **which decreases line item number 610 -Salaries & Wages by \$25,016.68, decreases line**
14 **item number 620-Fringe Benefits by \$7,755.18; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Modification-Amendment No. 01 increases line item number 712-Gas, Oil &**
16 **Coolants by \$1,680.90, increases line item number 721-Supplies-Other by \$15,861.00,**
17 **increases line item number 856-Client Support by \$109,719.96 and increases line item**
18 **860-Special Activities by \$2,000.00; and**

19 **WHEREAS, this budget has been reviewed by the Human Resources Development Committee and**
20 **the Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative Council.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
22 **approve and authorizes the expenditure of the attached budget for the FY 2007 One**
23 **Stop Division Bureau of Indian Affairs -477 Budget Modification-Amendment No.1 to**
24 **the base budget of \$899,698.34 and add carry over funds of \$93,930.00, which would**
25 **be a one time increase to the total base budget of \$993,628.34.**

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved proposed FY 2007 Budget Modification-Amendment**
27 **No.01, decreases line item number 610 -Salaries & Wages by \$25,016.68, decreases**
28 **line item number 620-Fringe Benefits by \$7,755.18, increases line item number 712-**

4 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
5 **Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairwoman and any official appointed designee is**
6 **hereby authorized to execute the budget, provided however, that any amendment**
7 **affecting the funding or funding levels of this budget shall be submitted for further**
8 **prior approval by this Council.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day**
10 **of MAY, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,053.9 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
11 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 386.9 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
12 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
13 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
14 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
15 **Stat. 984).**
