

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing the San Xavier District to submit a FY 2007 ICDBG application to HUD**  
**and to administer the grant, if awarded)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 07-265**

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council support the**  
2 **Districts in their efforts to improve quality of life for their community members; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, efforts to improve quality of life in any one District are beneficial for the Nation as a**  
4 **whole; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) offers money for housing**  
6 **rehabilitation under its Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG)**  
7 **program; and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District's Community Center is in dire need of rehabilitation; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District, and the Nation as a whole, has a waiting list of community**  
10 **members in need of new housing because they are living in sub-standard housing**  
11 **beyond rehabilitation or are living in a home with one or more additional families;**  
12 **and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District's Housing Department has a waiting list of community homes**  
14 **in need of rehabilitation; and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is not applying for the ICDBG this year; and**
- 16 **WHEREAS, the Ki:Ki Association is applying for the Imminent Threat Grant provided under the**  
17 **ICDBG, which does not conflict with the San Xavier District's application; and**
- 18 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District is eligible for ICDBG funds, as a P.L. 93-638 Title I entity,**  
19 **provided a concurring resolution is obtained from the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
20 **Council; and**
- 21 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District is eligible for ICDBG funds for new home construction provided**  
22 **it is deemed an eligible Community Based Development Organization (CBDO) by HUD;**  
23 **and**
- 24 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council, at its regular meeting on April 17, 2007, approved**  
25 **submission of an application for the ICDBG and requests a concurring resolution from**  
26 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**
- 27 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District agrees to accept all responsibility for the implementation and**  
28 **administration of projects conducted under this grant; and**

1 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District went before the Housing and Budget & Finance Committees**  
2 **requesting permission to submit an ICDBG application for the 2007 fiscal year.**

3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council**  
4 **authorizes the San Xavier District to submit an application to HUD for the FY 2007**  
5 **ICDBG, requesting funds for housing rehabilitations, new home construction and**  
6 **District Community Center rehabilitations; or, in the event the District is not deemed**  
7 **an eligible CBDO by HUD, to submit an application to HUD for the FY 2007 ICDBG,**  
8 **requesting funds for housing rehabilitations and District Community Center**  
9 **rehabilitations only.**

10 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that, should the grant be awarded, the San Xavier District will further**  
11 **submit for approval and acceptance of a final budget; and that any changes affecting**  
12 **funding amounts under this grant will be submitted for approval by the Tohono**  
13 **O'odham Legislative Council prior to changes taking effect.**

14 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
15 **of MAY, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,935.3 FOR; 505.5 AGAINST;**  
16 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2)**  
17 **& (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
18 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
19 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
20 **Stat. 984).**


