

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2007 Budget Amendment No. 2 for the Tohono O'odham Nation Police
Department BIA 638 Contract to add new position of Internal Affairs & create new
line items 721, 810, 750, 778)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-274

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation contracts its own Law Enforcement, Ranger and**
2 **Corrections Programs under the 638 BIA Master Contract; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) is amending the FY 2007**
4 **base budget by adding in \$1,048,473.70 from savings; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the TONPD is creating a new position for Internal Affairs Investigator; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has found the need to create new line items under Operational & Capital**
7 **for line items 721 - Supplies Other, 810 - Professional Services, 750 - Major Capital,**
8 **778 Alterations & Renovations; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the TONPD is creating line item 810 Professional Service to provide contract beds for**
10 **the Correctional Facility; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the TOPD is also obligating \$100,000.00 from the 638 Law Enforcement savings to use**
12 **asa one time match for the Tribal Resource Grant Program grant no. 2006HEWX0010.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
14 **accepts, approves, and authorizes Budget Amendment No. 2 for the following:**

- 15 **1) Create new position for Internal Affairs Investigator**
- 16 **2) To create new line items in Operational & Capital by adding 721 Supplies Other,**
17 **810 Professional Services, 750 Major Capital, 778 Alterations & Renovations**
- 18 **3) With additional changes this budget modification will change the FY 2007 budget**
19 **from \$2,841,708.37 to \$3,890,182.06**
- 20 **4) Use 638 savings to match the TRGP grant no. 2006HEWX0010 in the amount of**
21 **\$100,000.00 a one time match.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
23 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
24 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall**
25 **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
27 **of MAY, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,254.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 186.7 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
29 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
32 **Stat. 984).**


