

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2007 Budget Modification/Amendment No.2 for the Tohono O'odham Nation  
Police Department using salary savings to replenish over expended line items)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 07-277**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) has savings derived from**  
2 **vacant positions from Oct 1, 2006 to April 30, 2007 in the amount of \$194,381.45 leaving**  
3 **five (5) months salary available for new personnel; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has identified the need to utilize these salary savings to replenish several**  
5 **line items in need of increase such as 660 – Travel Expenses, 712 – Gas, Oil & Coolants,**  
6 **723 – Uniforms for new hires in Police, Corrections & Rangers, 729 – Animal Supplies**  
7 **& Feed, 771 – R&M of Vehicles, 810 – Professional Service, 850 – Food; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has also decreased or deleted line items that have not been used to**  
9 **increase these line items; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has also received a reimbursement from the Arizona Department of**  
11 **Emergency & Military Affairs Division of Emergency Management – Arizona Border**  
12 **Security Emergency in the amount of \$74,884.80 for border related issues; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the TONPD is requesting that this amount be placed in line item 810 – Professional**  
14 **Service to replenish this line item that is used for Forensic Science Center that**  
15 **provides autopsies; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the TONPD budget for FY 2007 will increase from \$6,351,262.52 to \$6,426,146.92 a one**  
17 **time increase with the reimbursement received in the amount of \$74,884.40.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts,**  
19 **approves, and authorizes the FY 2007 Law Enforcement Budget Amendment No. 2 as**  
20 **follows:**

- 21 **1) Use of salary savings of \$194,381.45 for replenishing of over expended line items;**
- 22 **2) Replenish line items 650 Travel Expenses, 712 Gas, Oil & Coolants, 723 Uniforms,**  
23 **729 Animal Supplies, 771 R&M of Vehicles, 850 Food;**
- 24 **3) Acceptance of a one time reimbursement of \$74,884.40 to be added to line item 810**  
25 **Professional Services; and**
- 26 **4) Changes the budget total from \$6,351,262.52 to \$6,426,146.92 a one time increase**  
27 **for FY 2007.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
29 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**

1 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be  
2 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup>. Day  
4 of MAY, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,975.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
5 278.3 NOT VOTING; and 186.7 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section  
6 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
7 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
8 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
9 Stat. 984).


