

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the FY 2007 Department of Health and Human Services Requests for
01-1300 Tribal Family Assistance/Child Welfare Budget Amendment #1 and
01-1305 Tribal Children's Home Program Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-284

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 06-210, Legislative Council approved allocation of \$89,665.01 for**
2 **the FY 2007 Tribal Family Assistance Budget, Account No. 01-1300; and**
3 **WHEREAS, by Resolution Nos. 06-612 and 06-661, Legislative Council approved and authorized**
4 **the Executive Branch to carry-forward the Tribal funding of \$882,450.06 recovered**
5 **after FY 2006 Tribal budget amendments and to carry-forward the unspent**
6 **balances of these FY 2006 Tribal budget amendments which amount to \$72,640.23,**
7 **for a total of \$955,090.29 accumulated in Tribal Welfare Assistance Grant (WAG)**
8 **savings, in order to meet the BIA WAG requirements of serving the Tohono O'odham**
9 **Nation; and**
10 **WHEREAS, the Nation continues to request from the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) for**
11 **additional Welfare Assistance Grant (WAG) funding in order to meet the BIA WAG**
12 **requirements of serving the Tohono O'odham Nation, subject to later approval by**
13 **the Legislative Council of annual funding agreements with the BIA, and subject to**
14 **Congressional appropriation of funding in FY 2007 or Continuing Resolution; and**
15 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services wishes to utilize the Tribal WAG**
16 **savings in order to meet the BIA WAG requirements of serving the Tohono O'odham**
17 **Nation for about four (4) months; and has prepared the attached FY 2007 Tribal**
18 **Family Assistance/Child Welfare Budget Amendment #1, which adds Tribal WAG**
19 **savings for about four (4) months funding to WAG line items, and the attached FY**
20 **2007 Tribal Children's Home Program Budget, which utilizes Tribal WAG savings to**
21 **provide additional operations and about four (4) months funding for personnel;**
22 **and has presented these to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

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1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services has recognized the increases in the**
2 **costs of services and number of people requiring services, while national funding**
3 **levels for BIA WAG are consistently decreasing; and has presented to the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Legislative Council Committees its request to again carry-forward the**
5 **unspent balances of these budgets, in order to meet the BIA WAG requirements of**
6 **servicing the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Nation shall spend all related FY 2007 BIA WAG funding first before related**
8 **Tribal funding in the above program budgets, and shall replace any Tribal funds**
9 **spent from the above program budgets when additional FY 2007 BIA WAG funds are**
10 **received.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
12 **approve and authorize the Executive Branch to expend funds for the attached FY**
13 **2007 Tribal Family Assistance/Child Welfare Budget Amendment #1 which adds**
14 **Tribal WAG savings for about four (4) months funding to WAG line items; and the**
15 **attached FY 2007 Tribal Children's Home Program Budget, which utilizes Tribal WAG**
16 **savings to provide additional operations and about four (4) months funding for**
17 **personnel; effective October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007, inclusive of budget**
18 **modifications during this period, in the following amounts:**

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26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve and**
27 **authorize the Executive Branch to carry-forward the unspent balances of these FY**
28 **2007 Tribal budgets, in order to meet the BIA WAG requirements of servicing the**
29 **Tohono O'odham Nation, provided however, that the Executive Branch shall present**
30 **to the Districts first for prior consideration of any additional requests of Desert**
31 **Diamond Gaming Savings desired to meet the BIA WAG requirements of servicing the**
32 **Tohono O'odham Nation, before submitting these requests to the Tohono O'odham**
33 **Legislative Council.**

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1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation shall spend all related FY 2007 BIA WAG funding first**
2 **before related Tribal funding in the above program budgets, and shall replace any**
3 **Tribal funds spent from the above program budgets when additional FY 2007 BIA**
4 **WAG funds are received.**

5 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials to wit: the Chairwoman and**
6 **any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate, execute and expend**
7 **funds, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels**
8 **shall be submitted for further prior approval.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH. Day**
10 **of MAY, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,908.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
11 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 532.3[10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
12 **1 (d) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
13 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
14 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
15 **Stat. 984).**
