9		with an option to renew the lease for three additional terms of five years each, for a
10		total term of twenty-five years; and
11	WHEREAS,	the rental rate agreed upon is \$1.17 per rentable square foot, and will be in place for
12		the ten year primary term, and may be increased for the subsequent five year option
13		terms in accordance with the increase in the consumer price index; and
14	WHEREAS,	DVA Renal Healthcare, Inc., will operate 20 stations at the opening of the facility, and
15		will expand to utilize additional stations as demand for dialysis treatment expands;
