9	WHEREAS, the Compact allows for waiver of state certification requirements f	or the licenses of
10	vendors if the state determines that such certification is not necess	ary to protect the
11	public interest; and	
12	WHEREAS, the Gaming Office of the Tohono O'odham Nation recommends an	nendment to the
13	provisions for vendor licensing in the Gaming Ordinance to allow t	he Gaming Office
14	to waive the vendor licensing requirements if the Gaming Office dete	rmines that such
15	licensing is not necessary to protect the public interest; and	
16	WHEREAS, the Gaming Enterprise of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Comm	nerce Committee
17	of the Legislative Council support the recommended amendmen	t to the Gaming

26	supplier of Gaming Services also shall be licensed by the Gam	ing Office before
27	providing Gaming Services to the Gaming Facility Operator. The services of the facility operator.	he Gaming Office
28	may waive the requirement of a license under this section

8	4.	The amendments to the Gaming Ordinance approved hereby shall be effective,
9		immediately, subject only to disapproval by the National Indian Gaming
10		Commission.
11	5.	The Chairperson of the Tohono O'odham Nation is authorized and directed to
12		submit the amended Gaming Ordinance to the National Indian Gaming
13		Commission for approval, and to take all other reasonable and necessary steps
14		for implementation of this Resolution.
