

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2007 PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare Budget Amendment #1 for
Division of Child Welfare Services, and approving the budget continuation)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-308

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 06-534, the Legislative Council approved allocation of \$1,375,906.67**
2 **for the FY 2007 PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare Budget, Account No. 01-1443 as a one**
3 **time funding appropriated from Tribal surplus funding, for the Department of Health**
4 **and Human Services, Division of Child Welfare Services; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Division of Child Welfare Services had already demonstrated in its Child Welfare**
6 **Master Plan the critical needs for additional Child Welfare and Family Preservation**
7 **resources to continue serving the vulnerable children and families of the Tohono**
8 **O'odham Nation in its ongoing commitment to protect vulnerable children from child**
9 **abuse and neglect and to promote safe and stable families; and**

10 **WHEREAS, by approval of the Nation's Executive Office and Legislative Council Committees, the**
11 **Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child Welfare Services**
12 **presents the attached FY 2007 PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare Budget Amendment #1,**
13 **effective October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007, in the amount of \$1,375,906.67**
14 **as a one time funding appropriated from Tribal surplus funding, for the Department**
15 **of Health and Human Services, Division of Child Welfare Services, which utilizes**
16 **unspent personnel savings to fund an additional position, vehicle and modular**
17 **building, to add new operations line items, and to change amounts in operational and**
18 **capital line items; and**

19 **WHEREAS, by approval of the Nation's Executive Office and Legislative Council Committees, the**
20 **Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child Welfare Services**
21 **presents its requests for the budget continuation of PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare**
22 **Budget as a reoccurring Tribal budget in order to continue providing the necessary**
23 **personnel, operations and capital for the critical needs of vulnerable children and**
24 **families of the Tohono O'odham Nation who are served by the Division of Child Welfare**
25 **Services, and also its plan to request for the carry-forward of any unspent FY 2007**
26 **funds from this budget in order to fund the increased costs of the buildings to provide**
27 **these necessary services.**


1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
2 **approve and authorize the Executive Branch to utilize unspent personnel savings to**
3 **fund an additional position, vehicle and modular building, to add new operations line**
4 **items, and to change amounts in operational and capital line items for the attached**
5 **FY 2007 PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare Budget Amendment #1.**

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve and**
7 **authorize the budget continuation of PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare Budget as a**
8 **reoccurring Tribal budget in order to continue providing the necessary personnel,**
9 **operations and capital for the critical needs of vulnerable children and families of the**
10 **Tohono O'odham Nation who are served by the Division of Child Welfare Services.**

11 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials to wit: the Chairperson and**
12 **any designated official are hereby authorized to expend the funds, provided however,**
13 **that any budget amendments affecting the funding levels shall be submitted for prior**
14 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST. Day**
16 **of MAY, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
17 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 04 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**
18 **& (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
19 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
20 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
21 **Stat. 984).**


