1 **WHEREAS, at a regular scheduled meeting of the Baboquivari District Council, held on May 9,**
2 **2007, of which a quorum was present; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Topawa Community Representatives presented a request to amend their 2007**
4 **budget; and**

5 **WHEREAS, at a Topawa community meeting, held on May 5, 2007, members present, accepted**
6 **and approved to amend their 2007 budget by utilizing carryover dollars from FY's**
7 **2000-\$60,678.70, 2001-\$41,102.51, and 2002-\$46,156.83, for a total amount of**
8 **\$147,938.04; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the amendment will be applied to the following line items:**

30 **depleting carryover dollars for said mentioned years.**

31 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any changes in the justifications, additions and/or transfer offunds**
32 **between budget line items are to be reviewed and approved by the Budget & Finance**
33 **Committee and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
