Program budget for FY 2007 in the amount of \$299,670.00 to include a matching
amount of \$99,890.00 to be funded from the 638 Law Enforcement FY 2007 budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 07-399

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) has successfully received and**
2 **accepted an award with the Community Oriented Policing Service (COPS) Tribal**
3 **Resource Grant Program (TRGP) equipment award, funded through the U.S**
4 **Department of Justice (USDOJ) for the amount of \$299,670.00 with a matching amount**
5 **of \$99,890.00 at a total amount of \$399,560.00 under grant award number**
6 **2006HEWX0010 with effective dates of August 1, 2006 through July 31, 2008 Resolution**
7 **No. 06-755; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has identified the match funds to be funded out of the 638 Law Enforcement**
9 **budget 10-1090 in the amount of \$99,890.00 Resolution No. 07-274; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has created a budget with line items 721 supplies at \$89,260.00, 723**
11 **uniforms at \$5,000.00, 771 R&M vehicles at \$4,000.00, 750 capital at \$201,410.00.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
13 **approves and authorizes the following:**

- 14 **1) The budget for FY 2007 under TRGP grant number 2006HEWX0010 in the amount**
15 **of \$299,670.00 to include a matching amount of \$99,890.00 to be funded from 638**
16 **Law Enforcement FY 2007 budget 10-1090.**
17 **2) The TRGP grant no. 2006HEWX0010 award does not appropriate an Indirect Cost**
18 **Reimbursement.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
20 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget**
21 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH. Day**
24 **of JUNE, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
26 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
27 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


