1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority ("TOFA") is the Tohono O'odham Nation's
2		("Nation's") enterprise authorized to operate the San Lucy, Schuk Toak, and Vaiva Vo
3		Farms on behalf of the Nation; and
4	WHEREAS,	TOFA is responsible for promoting the economic development and general welfare of
5		the Nation and its members by profitably developing the agricultural resources of the
6		Nation, pursuant to Paragraph 3.1 of TOFA's Second Restated Plan of Operation; and
7	WHEREAS,	in 2004, after evaluating various financing options to sustain farming operations, and
8		after consulting with the Chairwoman and Treasurer of the Nation, TOFA selected the
9		Bank of America ("BofA") as the best qualified lender to provide a Revolving Line of
10		Credit of \$4 Million and a Term Loan of \$1.5 Million as the best alternative to improve
11		the financial condition of the farming operation; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council must approve waivers of sovereign immunity,
13		both for the Nation and enterprises chartered pursuant to the laws of the Nation, such
14		as TOFA; and
15	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 04-460 (September 22, 2004), the Tohono O'odham Legislative
16		Council:
17		(a) approved the limited waivers of sovereign immunity in the Financing Documents
18		between TOFA and BofA, which are listed below:
19		(1) Business Loan Agreement for the \$4 Million Revolving Line of Credit and \$1.5
20		Million Term Loan,
21		(2) Secured Promissory Note for the \$1.5 Million Term Loan,
22		(3) Security Agreement-Agricultural Credit placing liens on farm products and related
23		collateral,
24		(4) Environmental Indemnity Agreement to indemnify BofA from farming impacts on
25		the environment, and
26		(b) authorized the Chairwoman of the Nation to execute a Security Agreement-Pledge
27		by the Nation pledging interest income on the SAWRSA Trust Account to secure
28		payment of TOFA's Revolving Line of Credit and Term Loan; and

1	WHEREAS,	TOFA's Management Board executed the Financing Documents in early October, 2004;
2		and
3	WHEREAS,	on May 6, 2005, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted Resolution No. 05-
4		233 (Delegating to the Nation's Chairwoman Authority Over the Tohono O'odham
5		Farming Authority); and
6	WHEREAS,	due to the impending maturity date of the Business Loan Agreement on December 31,
7		2005 combined with the ongoing need for financing to fund operations and crop
8		production, TOFA initiated negotiations with BofA to amend the Financing Documents
9		to extend the Availability Period to July 1, 2006 to provide financing for FY2006
10		operations and crop production; and
11	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 05-649 (October 26, 2005), the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
12		approved amendments to the Financing Documents to extend the Availability Period,
13		as defined in Sections 1.A.1.1(b) of the Business Loan Agreement, to July 1, 2006; and
14	WHEREAS,	during the pendency of the TOFA-BofA transaction, TOFA required emergency funding
15		to continue farming operations and crop production, and pursuant to Resolution No.
16		05-650 (October 26, 2005) the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorized the
17		Nation to approve a \$2.5 Million Emergency Loan to TOFA funded from the SAWRSA
18		Trust Account for operations and cotton harvesting; and
19	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 06-410 (June 28, 2006), the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
20		approved amendments to the Financing Documents to:
21		(1) increase the revolving line of credit to \$7.3 Million,
22		(2) extend the Availability Period to use the loan proceeds from December 31, 2005 to
23		July 1, 2007,
24		(3) extend the maturity date of the Business Loan Agreement to July 1, 2007, and
25		(4) limit the scope on the use of the loan proceeds to (a) equipment purchases, (b)
26		operations, and (c) to make scheduled payments on the revolving line of credit or
27		term loan; and
28	WHEREAS,	due to the impending maturity date of the Business Loan Agreement on July 1, 2007
29		combined with the ongoing need for financing to fund operations and crop
30		production, it is critical that TOFA continue to receive this financing in a timely

1	manner so that it can continue its operations, crop production, and maintain its
2	relationships with its vendors; and
3	WHEREAS, in order to continue the TOFA financing past July 1, 2007, BofA has proposed execution
4	of the following Amended Financing Documents:
5	(1) Second Amended and Restated Security Agreement Pledge,
6	(2) Security Agreement-Pledge Third Modification Agreement Acknowledgement
7	and Approval, and
8	(3) Revolving Line of Credit Third Modification Agreement, which further extends the
9	Availability Period to July 1, 2008; and
10	WHEREAS, the Second Amended and Restated Security Agreement-Pledge and Security
11	Agreement-PledgeAcknowledgement and Approval to be executed between the BofA
12	and the Nation on behalf of TOFA is necessary to:
13	(1) pledge interest income from the SAWRSA Trust Account in the amount of \$9.5
14	Million during the loan period, and
15	(2) acknowledge and approve the debt between TOFA and BofA; and
16	WHEREAS, TOFA requests that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approve the limited
17	waiver of TOFA's sovereign immunity necessary to execute the Revolving Line of Credit
18	Third Modification Agreement between TOFA and BofA.
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:
20	(1) Grants the limited waiver of TOFA sovereign immunity necessary to implement the
21	dispute resolution remedies provided for in Sections 15 and 16 of the Second
22	Amended and Restated Security Agreement Pledge, as required by subparagraph
23	9.2.2(A) of TOFA's Second Restated Plan of Operation, and authorizes TOFA to enter
24	into the Revolving Line of Credit Third Modification Agreement substantially in the
25	form attached hereto, and any instrument or agreement required under that
26	Agreement, and authorizes the Chairperson of the Nation, on behalf of TOFA, to
27	execute and deliver the Revolving Line of Credit Third Modification Agreement to
28	the BofA.
29	(2) Grants the limited waiver of the Nation's sovereign immunity necessary to
30	implement the dispute resolution remedies provided for in Sections 15 and 16 of

5	form attached hereto, in order to pledge \$9.5 Million of the interest earned on the
6	SAWRSA Trust Account held by the Bank of America to secure performance of
7	TOFA's Revolving Line of Credit and Term Loan with the Bank of America.
8	(3) Authorizes the Chairperson of the Nation to execute such further documents as
9	may be reasonably necessary to implement the intent of this resolution.
