3	stops within the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
4	WHEREAS, the USBP and TONPD is requesting to present the said information to the Tohono
5	O'odham Communities and/or districts; and
6	WHEREAS, the proposed presentation will help to inform the Nation's members on how to
7	interact and what to expect when they are involved in a traffic stop with Officers of the
8	USBP or TONPD.
9	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
10	supports the United States Border Patrol (USBP) and Tohono O'odham Nation Police
11	Department (TONPD) in joint efforts to provide training and video seminars of the
12	USBP and TONPD Traffic Stop Safety Tips and Video information to the Tohono
13	O'odham Nation's communities and/or District members.
14	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>13<sup>TH</sup>.</u> Day
15	of <u>IULY, 2007</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,249.3</u> FOR; <u>-0-</u> AGAINST;

17	1(c)(2)and1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
18	Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
19	Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
20	18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
