5		Arizona (ITCA); and
6	WHEREAS,	the services provided to the Elders and Caregivers are beneficial and services continue
7		to  be  necessary  in  order  to  provide  nutrition, transportation, so cialization  and  he althorough  and  constant  constant
8		promotion support to the Elders; and Caregiver support to the Caregivers of Elders
9		and Elders caring for Grandchildren; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Fiscal Year 2008 Title III-B \$46,723.00, C-1 \$93,705.00, C-2 \$35,744.00, E \$28,314.00,
11		D- Health Promotion \$6,117.00 and the Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP)
12		\$7,555.00 program budgets were prepared to utilize the Title III of the Older
13		Americans grant to continue nutrition, socialization, transportation and Caregiver
14		support services to eligible Elders and Caregivers of the Nation; and
15	WHEREAS,	the FY 2008 budgets were prepared in accordance with the Executive Branch FY-2008
16		Budget Development Instructions which authorizes 2.5 percent Cost of Living salary
17		increases to be effective October 1, 2007.
18	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
19		approves:
20		1. The Administration on Aging, fiscal year 2008 Title III B \$46,723.00; C-1
21		\$93,705.00; C-2 \$35,744.00; E \$28,314.00; D-Health Promotion \$6,117.00 and
22		Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) \$7,555.00 budgets that will be
23		necessary to maintain current services and includes the 2.5 percent Cost of
24		Living salary increases to be effective October 1, 2007.
25		2. The Tohono O'odham Nation officials to wit, the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and
26		any designated official is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
27		provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels
28		of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
