1	WHEREAS,	on September 29, 2005, the Director of Public Safety presented a resolution
2		designating the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as the basis for all
3		incident management for the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation); and
4	WHEREAS,	such resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council as Resolution
5		#05-593; and
6	WHEREAS,	such resolution created an Office of Emergency Management (OEM) to:
7		1. Incorporate NIMS into existing training programs and exercises;
8		2. Seek federal preparedness funding sufficient to support NIMS implementation;
9		3. Incorporate NIMS in emergency operations plans;
10		4. Provide and coordinate technical assistance to all Tohono O'odham Nation
11		agencies regarding NIMS to ensure compliance;
12		5. Promote mutual aid agreements with state and local entities;
13		6. Institutionalize the use of NIMS; and
14		7. Lead the effort to achieve NIMS compliance to ensure continued eligibility for
15		federal Homeland Security and other funding; and
16	WHEREAS,	the OEM has become the program that leads coordination, collaboration and other
17		efforts that help the Tohono O'odham Nation prepare, prevent, mitigate, respond and
18		recover from disaster events or other significant incidents that affect the members
19		and culture of the Nation; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Office of Emergency Management does not have program staff or specific funds to
21		fulfill the mission of comprehensive emergency management; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Office of Emergency Management currently pulls funds from a critical area, the
23		Nation's law enforcement BIA-638 funds, and should have an individual budget to
24		address the multitude of tasks and resources currently not available; and
25	WHEREAS,	the need for an OEM program budget and staff has been recognized by all levels of
26		government for continued support of such efforts as well as further supporting the
27		incident management needs of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Office of the Chairman has directed the Department of Public Safety to provide
29		such a budget that is for the remainder of FY 2007 in the amount \$256,005.12 which
30		reflects approximately one-sixth of the actual developed budget in the amount of
