

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Representative Gerald Fayuant to the NCAI Workgroup on Reporting,
Accountability and Auditing and Appointing Representative Cynthia Manuel
as the Nation's Alternate)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-531

1 **WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians ("NCAI") has formed several national**
2 **workgroups consisting of tribal leaders to advise and work with the Bureau of Indian**
3 **Affairs ("BIA") on issues affecting Indians nationwide; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the NCAI encourages tribal leaders to continue their strong participation and to have**
5 **a voice on important national issues and the Tohono O'odham Nation wishes to do the**
6 **same; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the NCAI has established a national workgroup on Reporting, Accountability and**
8 **Auditing to advise the BIA on how to develop a consistent reporting format in order to**
9 **more readily identify unmet needs, justify increased appropriations to tribes, and**
10 **provide accountability to the United States Congress on the use of such funds; and**

11 **WHEREAS, prior to the reappointment of legislative committee memberships on June 11, 2007,**
12 **the Legislative Council reaffirmed the appointment of Representative Gloria Ramirez,**
13 **a member of the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee, to the national**
14 **workgroup representing the Tohono O'odham Nation (Resolution No. 07-091).**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby appoints**
16 **Representative Gerald Fayuant as the Tohono O'odham Nation's representative on the**
17 **NCAI Reporting, Accountability and Auditing Workgroup, and appoints Representative**
18 **Cynthia Manuel as Representative Fayuant's alternate; provided that an appointment**
19 **made pursuant to this Resolution (1) shall supercede any prior NCAI Reporting,**
20 **Accountability and Auditing Workgroup appointment and (2) shall expire if the**
21 **appointee is no longer serving on the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee for**
22 **any reason.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
24 **of AUGUST, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,269.7 FOR; -0-**
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 264.8[05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
26 **Section 1 (d)(f)&(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
27 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
28 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
29 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
