

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2008 Tohono O'odham Department of Health & Human Services,
Division of Community Health - Women Infants & Children (WIC) Program Proposed
Budget of \$161,100.00 Account #12-1436)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-604

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Department of Health and Human Services-Division of Community Health-Women**
3 **Infants Children (WIC) program which provides preventive health care; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona through an Intergovernmental Agreement**
5 **receives funds from the United States Department of Agriculture for programs**
6 **designed to benefit women, infants and children; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with**
8 **Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants and Children**
9 **(WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2008;**
10 **which was approved through Resolution No. 02-439; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue**
12 **to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of**
13 **individuals at risk; and**

14 **WHEREAS, WIC has submitted the FY08 WIC budget and proposal in the amount of \$161,100.00.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

16 **1. The Tohono O'odham Nation approves and authorizes expenditures of the FY08**
17 **attached budget in the amount of \$161,100.00 from the Inter-Tribal Council of**
18 **Arizona to continue to operate and provide services to eligible women, infants and**
19 **children.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
21 **Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and any designated official to expend and administer the**
22 **budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding**
23 **level shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day**
26 **of SEPTEMBER, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,306.6 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; 227.9 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (d)(2), (d)(3) and 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
29 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
30 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act**
31 **of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
