

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving STEPS to a Healthier US Grant, STEPS to a Healthier Arizona Initiative
October 1, 2007 – September 30, 2008)

RESOLUTION NO. 07-606

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has applied, and been approved to receive, \$436,941.00**
2 **in competitive funding from the Arizona Department of Health Services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 99-149, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**
4 **establishment of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program, funded by the**
5 **Special Diabetes Programs for Indians, authorized by the Balanced Budget Act of 1997;**
6 **and**

7 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2000-182, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**
8 **name change of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program to the Healthy**
9 **O'odham Promotion Program; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services, Division of**
11 **Health Promotion Steps Program received and amended funding amount of**
12 **\$351,600.00, due to funding reductions in all Steps Communities; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services had received an**
14 **amended funding amount of \$342,500.00 for Fiscal Year 2008, due to funding**
15 **reductions in all Steps Communities; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services is requesting the**
17 **Fiscal Year 2008 base budget of \$342,500.00.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 19 **1. Approves and authorizes expenditures for the Division of Health Promotion**
20 **Program STEPS program budget of \$342,500.00 for FY 2008.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
22 **Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and any designated official to expend and administer the**
23 **budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding**
24 **level shall be submitted for further final approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
25 **Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH. Day**
27 **of SEPTEMBER, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1(d)(2), (d)(3) and 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
30 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
31 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act**
32 **of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
