

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Mutual Aid Agreement between the City of South Tucson and the  
Tohono O'odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 07-667**

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety/Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department would like**  
2 **to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement with the City of South Tucson in order to**  
3 **supplement the resources available to respond to fires and other types of**  
4 **emergencies; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the City of South Tucson and the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department both have**  
6 **the necessary resources to assist one another when responding to fires, medical**  
7 **emergencies, hazardous materials incidents, rescues, and other types of emergency**  
8 **incidents that are within the scope of services generally provided by both entities; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the purpose of this agreement is to increase each entities ability to provide a rapid**  
10 **response to emergency incidents with fire suppression and emergency medical**  
11 **personnel, and equipment by allowing the departments to respond with the closest**  
12 **available units and personnel into the other department's jurisdiction when**  
13 **requested; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the attached Mutual Aid Agreement with the City of South Tucson has been reviewed**  
15 **by the Office of Attorney General of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the proposed agreement and**  
17 **recommends approval by the Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
19 **the Mutual Aid Agreement with the City of South Tucson substantially in the form**  
20 **attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to**  
21 **execute it.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
23 **of OCTOBER, 2007 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
28 **Stat. 984).**
