

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2008 Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services,
Division of Community Health Motor Vehicle Injury Prevention STOP Project (\$71,480.00))

RESOLUTION NO. 08-040

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services has operated
2 the Motor Vehicle Injury Prevention Grant known as the STOP Project; and
3 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Community Health desires
4 to continue the prevention services of the STOP Project to reduce motor vehicle
5 injuries and death; and
6 WHEREAS, the Community Health Division has received Year Four continuation funding from the
7 U.S. Center for Disease Control and Prevention; and
8 WHEREAS, a budget in the amount of \$71,480.00 is submitted for review and approval to utilize
9 funds to continue the services it provides through the STOP Project.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:
11 1. Approves the new grant award in the amount of \$71,480.00 for Year Four of the
12 STOP Project.
13 2. Authorizes the Nation to incur expenditures upon approval of this resolution from
14 September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.

15 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
16 Nation officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated official
17 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any
18 amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for
19 further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH Day
21 of FEBRUARY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,269.7 FOR; -0-
22 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 264.8 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
23 Section 1 (d)(2) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by
24 the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
25 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
26 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




