7		"Approving Gu Achi District Fiscal Year 2008 Budget of \$1,192,981.78" which does state
8		that the "Gu Achi District has the authority to modify its FY 2008 budget in accordance
9		with protocols set forth by this Council. Any amendments affecting the funds of
10		funding levels of the Gu Achi District FY 2008 budget shall be approved by the Tohono
11		O'odham Legislative Council."; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution #07-764 "Approving Fl
13		2008 Additional Apportionment of Gaming Revenues to Districts" for additional
14		apportionments from the gaming revenues which also includes interest earned to
15		each of the eleven political districts; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Gu Achi District Council established a quorum at a regularly scheduled meeting
17		in the Community of Florence on January 26, 2008 to address issues pertaining to
18		district matters.
19	WHEREAS,	the Gu Achi District Council did pass the proposed amendment for their Gu Achi
20		District Fiscal Year 2008 Budget Amendment #1.
21	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
22		the Gu Achi District Fiscal Year 2008 Budget Amendment #1 as attached hereto.
23	BE IT FINAI	LY RESOLVED that the Gu Achi District reserves the right to modify its Fiscal Year
24		2008 budget according to the Tohono O'odham Nation's process, but any
25		amendments affecting the funds or funding levels shall be approved by the Tohono
