

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the 2008 Gu Achi District Budget from the Apportionment of Mining Royalties)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-045

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council established a quorum during the February**
2 **General Session to address issues pertaining to the nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council had passed Resolution #07-461 "Approving**
4 **FY 2008 Apportionment of Gaming Revenues to Districts by Equal Distribution" with**
5 **an amount of \$1,192,981.78; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council had also passed Resolution #07-552**
7 **"Approving Gu Achi District Fiscal Year 2008 Budget of \$1,192,981.78" which does state**
8 **that the "Gu Achi District has the authority to modify its FY 2008 budget in accordance**
9 **with protocols set forth by this Council. Any amendments affecting the funds or**
10 **funding levels of the Gu Achi District FY 2008 budget shall be approved by the Tohono**
11 **O'odham Legislative Council."; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution #07-752 "Approving FY**
13 **2008 Apportionment of Mining Royalties by Equal Distribution" for an additional**
14 **apportionment amount of \$266,596.95 from mining royalties to each of the eleven**
15 **political districts; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council established a quorum at a regularly scheduled meeting**
17 **in the Community of Florence on January 26, 2008 to address issues pertaining to**
18 **district matters and approved the Mining Royalties Apportionment Budget.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **2008 Gu Achi District budget from the Apportionment of Mining Royalties as attached**
21 **hereto.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Gu Achi District reserves the right to modify its Fiscal Year**
23 **2008 budget according to the Tohono O'odham Nation's process, but any**
24 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels shall be approved by the Tohono**
25 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH. Day**
27 **of FEBRUARY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,269.7 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 264.8 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1 (d)(2) and (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
30 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
