4	WHEREAS, the TONPD has agreed to cost share with utilization of contract beds at a total amount						
5	of \$233,280.00; and						
6	WHEREAS, the TONPD has agreed to fund part of the cost at a total of \$29,227.59 to be added to						
7	line item 810–Professional services with the remaining a mount of \$327.86 to be added						
8	to line item 711 – Communications; and						
9	WHEREAS, the TONPD has also deleted line item 750 – Capitol in the amount of \$10,000.00 to be						
10	put into line item 711 – Communications to cover the cost of phone services which						
11	brings the total amount added to the communications line item to the amount of						
12	\$10,327.86; and						
13	WHEREAS, this is recognized as a temporary funding solution that will require special funding for						
14	next fiscal year.
