

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Pima County for the Provision of Communicable Disease Investigative Services)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-066

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 07-162, entitled Requesting Assistance From Indian Health Service,**
2 **Personnel Deployment to Address Tohono O'odham Nation Disease Outbreaks in**
3 **Cooperation with Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services, the**
4 **Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") recognized that there is a concern for a sexually**
5 **transmitted disease ("STD") outbreak; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Department of Health and Human Services, in coordination with several**
7 **agencies including the Indian Health Service, Pima County, the State of Arizona and**
8 **the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona, as well as other departments and programs of the**
9 **Nation, worked to address the (STD) outbreak; and**

10 **WHEREAS, through this coordinated effort the Department of Health and Human Services and**
11 **Pima County Health Department determined that a more formal arrangement needed**
12 **to be in place to provide for technical assistance, training and oversight of current and**
13 **future disease intervention specialists working for the Nation; and**

14 **WHEREAS, an Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision of Communicable Disease**
15 **Investigation Services has been negotiated between the Nation and Pima County; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement has been reviewed by the Health and**
17 **Human Services Committee, which recommends approval by the Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
19 **the six month Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision of Communicable**
20 **Disease Investigation Services Between Pima County and the Tohono O'odham Nation**
21 **substantially in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation**
22 **to execute it and any subsequent amendments for extension of time, and authorizes**
23 **the Nation's Department of Health and Human Services to implement the agreement.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH. Day**
25 **of FEBRUARY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 1 (d)(2)&(3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**
28 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
