

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing a One Time Funding (Surplus Funds) in the amount of \$432,837.33
under FY 2008 for the Tohono O'odham Justice Center)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-070

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Justice Center serves the Nation by adjudicating criminal, traffic,**
2 **children's and civil cases filed before the court within the surrounding boundaries of**
3 **the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Executive Branch, Treasurer's Office, and the Budget &**
5 **Finance Committee that a general revenue surplus funds exist for expenditure by the**
6 **Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Branch; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Justice Center has prepared and presented the attached budget proposal that**
8 **identifies program line items determined to have the greatest need; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee and Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative Council**
10 **of Tohono O'odham Nation have reviewed this budget and recommends its approval.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
12 **authorizes the expenditure of funds identified in FY 2008 Tohono O'odham Justice**
13 **Center's One Time Funding (Surplus Funds) proposal in the amount of \$432,837.33 and**
14 **in accordance with the attached budget.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this supplemental request is a one time funding appropriation**
16 **and all un-obligated funds from this supplemental request is to return to the General**
17 **Fund.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
19 **Nation's Judicial Official, to wit: the Chief Judge, Deputy Chief Judge and any**
20 **designated official are authorized to negotiate and administer this budget, provided**
21 **however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the budget as**
22 **presented shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19TH. Day**
25 **of FEBRUARY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
