

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approve Two STD Poster Abstracts to be Presented at th National STD Conference**  
**to be held in Chicago on March 10-13, 2008)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 08-096**

1 **WHEREAS, on March 12, 2007 the Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 07-212 which declared**  
2 **a sexually transmitted disease (STD) outbreak on the Tohono O'odham Nation and**  
3 **requested assistance from Indian Health Service (IHS), the Arizona Department of**  
4 **Health Services (ADHS) and Pima County Health Department (PCHD) to coordinate and**  
5 **collaborate with the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services**  
6 **(TODHHS) in eliminating sexually transmitted disease on the Tohono O'odham Nation;**  
7 **and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Sells Service Unit (SSU) the ADHS, Sexually Transmitted Disease Programs and**  
9 **Pima County sexually transmitted disease program and the Center of Disease Control**  
10 **and Prevention (CDC) has been successful and have worked cooperatively and**  
11 **collaboratively with the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Department of Health and**  
12 **Human Services; and**

13 **WHEREAS, other entities including the Nation's Education Department, the Nation's Recreation**  
14 **programs, Tohono O'odham Youth Council, the Nation's radio station – KOHN as well**  
15 **at the Arizona Youth Partnership and the Inter-tribal Council of Arizona have worked**  
16 **together in a successful manner; and**

17 **WHEREAS, there scheduled the National 2008 STD Conference, "Confronting Challenges, Applying**  
18 **Solutions" in Chicago, Illinois on March 10-13, 2008; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Nation wishes to present a poster abstract to chronicle and describe lessons**  
20 **learned from the STD outbreak on the Nation to benefit tribal, state and county health**  
21 **departments nationwide; and**

22 **WHEREAS, two posters have been developed to be presented at the national STD conference, one**  
23 **poster that describes the management of the outbreak and a second that provides the**  
24 **epidemiological aspects of the outbreak; and**

25 **WHEREAS, the two posters has been reviewed by the Executive Office and Health and Human**  
26 **Services Oversight Committee.**

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the STD Conference Posters are hereby approved by the**  
28 **Legislative Council for presentation at the National STD Conference on March 10-13,**
