RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Declining to Participate in Judicial Court Review in the Absence of Adequate Notice, Information, or Consultation)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-107

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult "with
2		appropriate federal agencies regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono
3	-	O'odham Nation" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(j));
4		and
5	WHEREAS,	by its passage and implementation of the Indian Self-Determination and Education
6		Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. § 450 et seq.) and similar legislation, the United States of
7		America has recognized the need to work with Indian tribes on a government-to-
8		government basis and to support Indian tribal self-determination and self-
9		governance; and
10	WHEREAS,	Executive Order 13175 mandates that Executive Branch agencies work with tribes
11		when formulating and implementing policies or taking other actions that have a
12		$substantial\ direct\ effect\ on\ any\ Indian\ tribe\ (Executive\ Order\ 13175, ``Consultation\ and$
13		Coordination with Indian Tribal Governments" ("Consultation Order")); and
14	WHEREAS,	the Consultation Order and additional executive orders and memoranda require that
15		all Executive Branch agencies ensure that there is "meaningful" and "timely" tribal
16		input when formulating policies that have tribal implications; and
17	WHEREAS,	on March 10, 2008 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Chairman's Office, and

20		an assessment of the Tohono O'odham Judicial Court from March 10-14, 2008; and
21	WHEREAS,	the written scope of work for the review indicates that a review team will rate the
22		court's use of federal funds as acceptable, unacceptable, or report that no
23		determination was reached; and
24	WHEREAS,	${\bf a letter from the BIA Office of Justice Services to the BIA Western Region director states}$
25		that the review is "not mandatory, and the tribe can refuse without any consequences
26		from the Bureau"; and
27	WHEREAS,	it is unclear whether the review triggers formal tribal consultation, whether financial
28		and other information about the Judicial Court will be disclosed to other entities in
29		the federal government or elsewhere, or whether any rating could negatively impact
30		Judicial Court funding; and

1	WHEREAS, for these reasons it is not currently in the Nation's best interest to participate in the
2	review.
3	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby (1)
4	relies on the BIA Office of Justice Services' representation that the review is "not
5	mandatory, and the tribe can refuse without any consequences from the Bureau" and
6	(2) declines to participate in the review of the Tohono O'odham Judicial Court by
7	Coochise Consulting, LLC in the absence of adequate notice, information, or
8	consultation.
