13		Tohono O'odham Legislative Council through Resolution 05-489 and subsequently
14		signed by the former Chairwoman; and
15	WHEREAS,	on 01/16/07, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant from the Arizona
16	1	Department of Emergency and Military Affairs in the amount of \$44,000.00 as part of
17		the 2006 grant program; and
18	WHEREAS,	the use of carry forward funds of \$11,548.57 has been reviewed by the Office Grants &
19	·	Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance
20		Committee, of which all recommend approval of the carry forward funds by the
