

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Acceptance and Approval of the US Department of Homeland Security, State of Arizona**  
**Department of Homeland Security, 2007 State Homeland Security Grant for \$72,100.00,**  
**Grant #2007-GE-T7-0006)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 08-114**

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants to**  
2 **counties, through their respective states, to fund equipment purchases and training**  
3 **by departments that provide public safety services within their respective**  
4 **jurisdictions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive funds through the respective state,**  
6 **requiring tribes to sign a Letter of Offer and Acceptance; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated a Letter of Offer and Acceptance with the**  
8 **State of Arizona for the purpose of obligating and distributing funds from the U.S.**  
9 **Department of Homeland Security, Homeland Security Grant Program on a**  
10 **reimbursement basis to finance equipment purchases, training costs and other**  
11 **needs for homeland security; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Letter of Offer and Acceptance was approved in the form attached hereto by the**  
13 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council through Resolution 05-489 and subsequently**  
14 **signed by the former Chairwoman; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been awarded a grant from the Arizona Department**  
16 **of Emergency and Military Affairs in the amount of \$72,100.00 as part of the 2007 State**  
17 **Homeland Security Program Grant No. 2007-GE-T7-0006 for the purchase of specific**  
18 **equipment needed for enhancing the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department**  
19 **SWAT Team; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the 2007 grant award of \$72,100.00 has been reviewed by the Office Grants &**  
21 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**  
22 **Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative**  
23 **Council.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**  
25 **accepts the award for the 2007 State Homeland Security Program Grant No. 2007-GE-**  
26 **T7-0006 in the amount of \$72,100.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono**  
27 **O'odham Nation General Fund for the purchase of equipment needed for enhancing**  
28 **the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department SWAT Team.**

29 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department, is authorized to**  
30 **expend funds from this grant in the amount of \$72,100.00 in accordance with the**

1 terms of the grant award and with any extensions of time reasonably necessary which  
2 are approved by the granting agency, to be brought back to the Tohono O'odham  
3 Legislative Council for approval.

4 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Office of the  
5 Chairman or designee to expend funds in accordance with the terms of the grant  
6 award period of 09/01/07 to 07/31/09 with any grant extensions of time reasonably  
7 necessary which are approved by the granting agency to be brought back to the  
8 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for approval.

9 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day  
10 of MARCH, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,156.9 FOR; -0-  
11 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 377.6 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
12 Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
13 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
14 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
15 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
