9	WHEREAS, Sylvia Alvarez, an enrolled member of the Tohono O'odham Nation, has requested a						
10	donation from the Legislative Council to assist with burial expenses for her late sister,						
11	Olga Escarsega; and						
12	WHEREAS, Sylvia Alvarez has therefore requested assistance from the Legislative Branch.						
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby						
14	approves a donation to Sylvia Alvarez from the FY 2008 Legislative Branch budget						
15	donations/contributions line item 852 in the amount of \$1,495.00 to assist with Olga						
16	Escarsega's funeral expenses.
