

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY2008 General Support Services – Accounting Office Budget Amendment No. 2)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-136

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY2008 Accounting Office**
2 **Budget pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 07-588; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Accounting Office of the Executive Branch submits for review and approval FY2008**
4 **Accounting Office Budget Amendment No. 2 transferring funds within line items to**
5 **decrease line items 650, 660, 661, 712 and 770 and increase line items 720, 810 and 850**
6 **in addition, revises the justification for line item 750 Capital Equipment, changing the**
7 **type of vehicle to purchase; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the FY2008 Accounting Office Budget Amendment No. 2 has been reviewed and**
9 **approved by the Budget and Finance Committee; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved Resolution No. 08-075 a**
11 **supplemental funding request for the Accounting Office which included funding to**
12 **purchase vehicles for the Property & Supply Office.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
14 **the FY2008 Accounting Office Budget Amendment No. 2 which transfers funds within**
15 **line items, decreasing line items 650, 660, 661, 712 and 770 and increases line items**
16 **720, 810 and 850.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approval of this amendment revises the budget**
18 **justification of line item 750 Capital Equipment to the following:**

19 **Revise justification from:**

20 **“To purchase a vehicle available to Property & Supply needs with hydraulic**
21 **lift @ \$21,250.”**

22 **Revise justification to:**

23 **“To purchase a replacement vehicle for the Accounting Office 2000 Honda**
24 **Civic @ \$21,250.”**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that**
26 **the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any**
27 **designated official are authorized to administer the budget, provided however, that**
28 **any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted**
29 **for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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1 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH. Day**
2 **of MARCH, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0-**
3 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
4 **Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
5 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
6 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
7 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
