

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Commission FY - 2008
Budget Modification/Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 08-176

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, formerly called the Papago Tribe, enacted the Tribal**
2 **Employment Rights Ordinance in 1978 as Ordinance No. 1-78 and in 1985 as Ordinance**
3 **No. 01-85; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the continued enforcement of the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance 01-85 is**
5 **essential to increase employment of Indians and eradicate employment**
6 **discrimination on and near the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance No. 01-85 is outdated; and**

8 **WHEREAS, surplus funding for Fiscal Year 2008 have been identified as available for expenditure;**
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, the TERO Commission has proposed that \$24,000 in non-recurring funding be**
11 **appropriated and allocated to the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights**
12 **Commission budget (01-1071) for Fiscal Year 2008 to acquire professional services to**
13 **revise Ordinance No. 01-85; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Office of Attorney General will provide assistance to the TERO Commission to**
15 **finalize the attorney contract, and will review and recommend to the TERO**
16 **Commission the payment of attorney invoices; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Commission Fiscal Year 2008 Budget**
18 **Amendment No. 1 has been approved by the Domestic Affairs Committee and the**
19 **Budget and Finance Committee.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby:**

- 21 **1. Approves the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Commission Fiscal Year**
22 **2008 Budget Modification/Amendment No. 1, which increases the TERO**
23 **Commission budget by \$24,000.00 in non-recurring funding, providing a total**
24 **budget of \$36,008.00.**
- 25 **2. Appropriates the \$24,000.00 from the revenue surplus, and authorizes expenditure**
26 **of the funds in accordance with the budget.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
28 **of APRIL, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,335.3 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
29 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 199.2 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
30 **1 (d)(3)&(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
33 **Stat. 984).**
