

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the EEOC FY 2008 Budget Modification/Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-193

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights Office since**
2 **1978; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is to increase**
4 **employment of Indians on and near the Tohono O'odham Nation by enforcing Indian**
5 **Preference in employment, training, contracting, subcontracting and eradicate**
6 **employment discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the Tohono O'odham**
7 **Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office is**
9 **annually supplemented by the United States Equal Employment Opportunity**
10 **Commission through a contract in the amount of \$26,000.00; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the contract between the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the Tohono**
12 **O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office has been approved by the Office of the**
13 **Chairman; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the contract between the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the Tohono**
15 **O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office requires the Tohono O'odham Nation to**
16 **accept contract funds without withholding indirect costs.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is amending Resolution No. 07-**
18 **632, which approved the FY 2008 EEOC Budget which includes the Indirect Cost line**
19 **item, by deleting line item 900-Indirect Cost Charges from the budget.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the**
21 **Tribal Employment Rights Office FY 2008 Equal Employment Opportunity Commission**
22 **Budget Amendment No. 1 by moving the indirect cost charges in the amount of**
23 **\$4,215.33 into the Salaries and Fringe Benefits line items per attached budget.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby waives the**
25 **Indirect Cost requirement from future EEOC Budgets.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council hereby authorizes**
27 **the Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
28 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
29 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day of APRIL, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
