7	1) an increase of 955 new voters registered
8	2) 850 Early Votes Cast During General Election
9	3) an increase from 57% to 59% Voter Turn Out; and
10	WHEREAS, the upcoming 2008 state and federal election serves to be an important election for the
11	state of Arizona and the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
12	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation continues to recognize the importance of Tohono
13	O'odham Nation members participating in the democratic process as citizens of the
14	United States of America and has begun another "Get Out the Vote" Project for the
15	2008 state and federal election; and
16	WHEREAS, there exists savings from the NCAI Education grant awarded to the Nation; and
17	WHEREAS, the Executive Office and the Grants and Contracts Office have identified savings in the
18	amount of \$14,621.75 from the NCAI grant received and has received approval from
19	NCAI that the remaining funds can be expended for future Native Vote endeavors; and
20	WHEREAS, the Executive Office has presented the attached budget in the amount of \$14,621.75
21	for the 2008 "Get Out the Vote" project on the Tohono O'odham Nation.
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
23	use of NCAI grant saving of \$14,621.75 in accordance with the budget attached hereto
24	for the Tohono O'odham Nation Get Out the Vote Project.
