RESOLUTION NO. 08-207

1	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds within the exclusive
2	control of the Tohono O'odham Nation and to appropriate these funds for the
3	benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds
4	shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets" authorized by resolution or
5	ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and
6	WHEREAS, after decades of effort to secure a water settlement for lands within the Tohono
7	O'odham Nation (San Xavier District and Eastern Schuk Toak District), on December
8	14, 2007, Title III of the Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act became effective; and
9	WHEREAS, in recognition of the numerous tribal, federal, and state parties, officials, and
10	individuals who worked to achieve the passage and enforceability of Title III, the
11	Nation sponsored a Washington, D.C. reception, participated in a Arizona Water Rights
12	Settlement Act celebration on the Gila River Indian Community Reservation, and is
13	planning a celebration on the Nation for Nation's members; and
14	WHEREAS,partial funding for the events has been provided through the Arizona Water Rights
15	Settlement Act Reception and Acknowledgment Event Budget ("AWSA Budget") that
16	was previously approved by the Legislative Council; and
17	WHEREAS,the Water Resources Committee has requested that the AWSA Budget be amended to
18	decrease line item 860 – Special Activities by \$4000, add \$3000 to line item 812 – Public
19	Relations, and fund a new line item 852 – Donations in the amount of \$1000 as
20	provided in the attached AWSA Budget Amendment No. 1; and
21	WHEREAS, AWSA Budget Amendment No. 1 has been reviewed by the Legislative Budget and
22	Finance Committee and, if approved, it will not increase the total amount of funds
23	previously appropriated by the Legislative Council.
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby approves AWSA Budget
25	Amendment No. 1; provided that
26	(1) the amended budget shall be administered by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
27	Administration with the approval of expenditures and concurrence of the Tohono
28	O'odham Legislative Council Water Resources Committee;
