7	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is further vested with the power to "employ legal counsel for
8		the protection and advancement of the rights of the Tohono O'odham Nation" and
9		(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 2(a)); and
10	WHEREAS,	it is in the Nation's interest to employ a lobbyist in Washington, D.C. to effectively
11		consult with the Congress and federal agencies; provide advice regarding federal
12		appropriations, legislation, and programs; and, when authorized, act as a liaison
13		between the Nation and the United States; and
14	WHEREAS,	the  Legislative  Appropriations  Committee  and  the  Nation's  Chairman  have  prepared  and  the  Nation's  Chairman  and  t
15		and distributed a request for proposals for the Nation's lobbying firm, assessed the
16		${\bf qualifications\ of\ responding\ firms, scheduled\ and\ conducted\ interviews\ of\ qualified}$
17		firms, and rated the firms interviewed; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Nation's lobbying contract with Holland & Knight LLP expired on March 31, 2008;
19		and
20	WHEREAS,	the firm of Patton Boggs LLP is qualified to provide advice and representation as the
21		Nation's lobbyist; and
22	WHEREAS,	aFederalLobbyingContract, includinganExhibitAFY2008BillingRatesScheduleandAFY2008BillingRatesScheduleAFY2008
23		Retainer Letter dated April 7, 2008 (collectively, "Lobbying Contract"), has been
24		negotiated with Patton Boggs LLP (the "Attorneys") and has been approved as to form
25		by the Office of the Attorney General; and
26	WHEREAS,	sufficient funds remain within the FY 2008 Executive Admin Lobbying Provision
27		Budget line item 811-Lobby to fund the Lobbying Contract.
