

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Acceptance and Approval of the US Department of Homeland Security, Office of Grants  
and Training, 2006 State Homeland Security Grant#2006-GE-T6-0007 for \$44,500.00)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 08-232**

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants within the**  
2 **program period that was introduced on 11/01/06 to individual states, to fund**  
3 **equipment purchases, training and other programs by departments that provide**  
4 **public safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive funds through the respective state for**  
6 **the purpose of obligating and distributing funds from the U.S. Department of**  
7 **Homeland Security, Office of Grants and Training, Homeland Security Grant Program**  
8 **on a reimbursement basis to Strengthen Interoperable Communication Capabilities;**  
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, on 01/16/07, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant from the Arizona**  
11 **Department of Emergency and Military Affairs in the amount of \$44,500.00 as part of**  
12 **the 2006 State Homeland Security Program Grant No. 2006-GE-T6-0007 to provide**  
13 **funds to enhance interoperable communications for the Tohono O'Odham Nation;**  
14 **and**

15 **WHEREAS, the 2006 grant award of \$44,500.00 has been reviewed by the Office of Grants &**  
16 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**  
17 **Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative**  
18 **Council.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**  
20 **accepts the 2006 State Homeland Security Program Grant No. 2006-GE-T6-0007 award**  
21 **of \$44,500.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono O'odham Nation General**  
22 **Fund to provide funds to enhance interoperable communications for the Tohono**  
23 **O'Odham Nation.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation, Office of Emergency Management**  
25 **is authorized to expend funds from this 2006 State Homeland Security Program Grant,**  
26 **in the amount of \$44,500.00 in accordance with the terms of the grant and award**  
27 **period of 11/01/06 to 07/31/08.**

4 **U.S. Department of Homeland Security, State Homeland Security Grant, with any**  
5 **extensions of time reasonably necessary which are approved by the granting agency**  
6 **to be brought back to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for approval.**

7 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
8 **of MAY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
9 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of**  
10 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
11 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
12 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


