

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 08-122 entitled "Granting a Limited Waiver of the Sovereign
Immunity of San Xavier District for the Purpose of Issuing District Revenue Bonds for a
Federal Detention and Support Center")**

RESOLUTION NO. 08-235

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council enacted Resolution No. 08-122 to grant a**
2 **limited waiver of the sovereign immunity of San Xavier District for the purpose of the**
3 **District's issuance of revenue bonds to finance a proposed Federal Detention and**
4 **Support Center on allotted lands within the San Xavier District; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the amount of the revenue bonds presented in Resolution No. 08-122 was "in an**
6 **amount not to exceed \$38,000,000"; and**

7 **WHEREAS, Innovative Government Strategies, Inc., the developer for the Federal Detention and**
8 **Support Center, has now requested an increase of the initial bond amount from**
9 **\$38,000,000 to \$80,000,000 to insure that sufficient financing will be made available**
10 **to construct the proposed center; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has approved the change in the revenue bond amount**
12 **in Resolution No. SXDC 04-08-11.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby amends**
14 **Resolution No. 08-122 by increasing the revenue bond amount referred to in the third**
15 **Whereas clause from an amount not to exceed \$38,000,000 to an amount not to exceed**
16 **\$80,000,000 (excluding capitalized interest, costs of issuance and funding of debt**
17 **reserve, and other required bond funds) to finance the design, construction and**
18 **equipping of a Federal Detention and Support Center within the boundaries of the San**
19 **Xavier District.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other provisions of Resolution No. 08-122 shall remain in full**
21 **force and effect.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH. Day**
23 **of MAY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,861.9 FOR; 672.6 AGAINST;**
24 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(6)**
25 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
26 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
27 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
