

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office**  
**FY - 2008 Budget Modification/Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 08-246

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights Office since**  
2 **1978; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is to increase**  
4 **employment of Indians on and near the Tohono O'Odham Nation by enforcing Indian**  
5 **Preference in employment, training, contracting, subcontracting and to eradicate**  
6 **employment discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the Tohono O'odham**  
7 **Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tribal Employment Rights Office has identified savings in the Salary and fringe**  
9 **benefit line items in the amount of \$4,215.33; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tribal Employment Rights Office will be increasing the following line items,**  
11 **Supplies-Office by \$1,775.16 and Supplies-Other by \$1,775.17; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tribal Employment Rights Office will also be adding a new line item identified as**  
13 **01-1070-727 Building Materials with an amount of \$665.00; and**

14 **WHEREAS, this increase and additional line item does not increase the original budget amount**  
15 **of \$255,178.42.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**  
17 **hereby approves the Tribal Employment Rights Office to increase line items 01-1070-**  
18 **720 Supplies-Office by \$1,775.16 and 01-1070-721 Supplies-Other by \$1,775.17**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby approves the**  
20 **Tribal Employment Rights Office to add a new line item identified as 01-1070-727**  
21 **Building Materials with an amount of \$665.00 and that it does not increase the original**  
22 **budget amount of \$255,178.42.**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby approves the**  
24 **Tribal Employment Rights Office FY 2008 Budget Modification/Amendment No. 1 in the**  
25 **amount of \$255,178.42.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation Legislative Council hereby authorizes**  
27 **the Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
28 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**  
29 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.**




