

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the Fiscal Year 2009 Budget for the Tohono O'odham Nation Justice Center**  
**and Appropriating Funds in the Amount of \$5,461,435.60)**

RESOLUTION NO. 08-266

1 **WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2008 will end at midnight, September 30, 2008 and all spending**  
2 **authority granted under the 2008 budgets terminate at that time; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch of the Nation has prepared and presented a budget to the**  
4 **Legislative Council that reflects the needs of the Branch, a copy of the proposed said**  
5 **budget is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the proposed FY 2009 Judiciary Budget includes employees salary in the amount of**  
7 **\$3,658,826.03, other compensation at \$147,640.49, fringe benefits at 32% in the**  
8 **amount of \$1,218,069.29, and operational cost in the amount of \$436,899.79, totaling**  
9 **\$5,461,435.60 for FY 2009; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative**  
11 **Council of Tohono O'odham Nation have reviewed this budget and recommends its**  
12 **approval and adoption.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation has**  
14 **reviewed and approved the Fiscal Year 2009 budget submitted by the Judicial Branch.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$5,461,435.60 is appropriated and**  
16 **authorized to be expended from the general funds approved by this Council for**  
17 **support of the Fiscal Year 2009 budget of the Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
19 **Chief Judge and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
20 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall**  
21 **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22<sup>ND</sup> Day**  
23 **of MAY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
24 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1**  
25 **(d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
28 **Stat. 984).**


