

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Legislative Branch FY 2008 Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-268

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is authorized “to manage any funds within the exclusive**
2 **control of the Tohono O’odham Nation ... and to appropriate these funds for the**
3 **benefit of the nation and its members” provided that all expenditures of these funds**
4 **shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets authorized by resolutions or**
5 **ordinances, (Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2);**
6 **and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Administration has identified a need to modify and amend the**
8 **current FY 2008 budget approved by the Legislative Council in order to fairly**
9 **compensate Branch employees and reflect existing position vacancies; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, there has been an in-house promotion to a vacant position and a transfer to another**
11 **vacant position; and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, the existing salary for this position (Assistant Legislative Secretary) will revert back**
13 **to the base salary in the amount of \$33,196.00; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, it is also proposed to reclassify the Legal Secretary position to a Legislative Assistant**
15 **position and this would require amending the approved salary for that position to**
16 **\$46,193.00; and**
- 17 **WHEREAS, it is further proposed to have the modified salaries for the Assistant Legislative**
18 **Secretary and the Legislative Assistant be retro-active to May 19, 2008; and**
- 19 **WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in the Legislative Branch FY 2008 Budget to support the**
20 **proposed FY 2008 Budget Amendment No. 1, which has been submitted to the Budget**
21 **and Finance Committee for its review.**
- 22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
23 **and authorizes Legislative Branch FY 2008 Budget Amendment No. 1, which shall be**
24 **funded with existing funds within the Legislative Branch FY 2008 Budget.**
- 25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the current salary of the Assistant Legislative Secretary is amended**
26 **to the minimum base salary of that position, which is \$33,196.00.**
- 27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposal for reclassification of the Legal Secretary position**
28 **to a Legislative Assistant position and the required amendment of the approved**
29 **salary for that position to \$46,193.00 is also hereby approved.**
- 30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that modified salaries for the Assistant Legislative Secretary and the**
31 **Legislative Assistant shall be retro-active to May 19, 2008.**

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels shall be
2 submitted for further prior approval by the Legislative Council.

3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28TH Day
4 of MAY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,262.1 FOR; 158.45
5 AGAINST; 113.95 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
6 Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
7 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
8 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
9 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
